Ballot Questions

In addition to deciding who represents New York in Albany and Washington DC, voters will decide four [ballot questions](#).

New York City voters will be asked:

- Shall the City add a preamble to the city charter that includes a statement of values and vision that aims to create a just and equitable city for all?
- Shall the City establish a racial equity office, plan and commission?
- Shall the City use a new method to calculate the true cost of living?

All New York State voters will be asked:

- Shall the Environmental Bond Act of 2022 be approved?
